It is easy to bypass this error! Here is how:

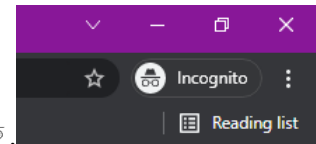
1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click More  > **New Incognito Window.**

3. A new window appears. In the top right corner, check for the Incognito icon .
4. Remember to turn off Block third-party cookies.

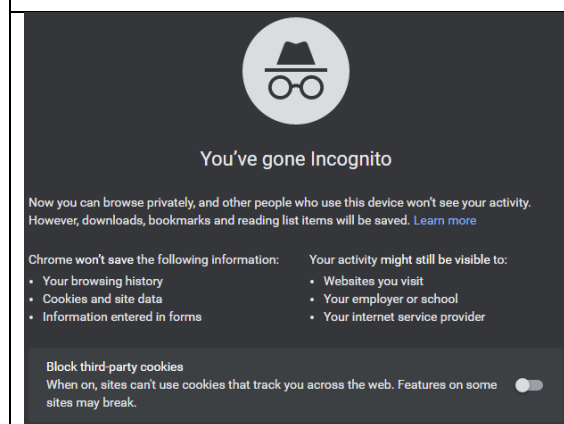
You can also use a keyboard shortcut to open an Incognito window:

- Windows, Linux, or Chrome OS: Press **Ctrl + Shift + n**.
- Mac: Press **⌘ + Shift + n**.

You can switch between Incognito windows and regular Chrome windows. You'll only browse in private when you're using an Incognito window.

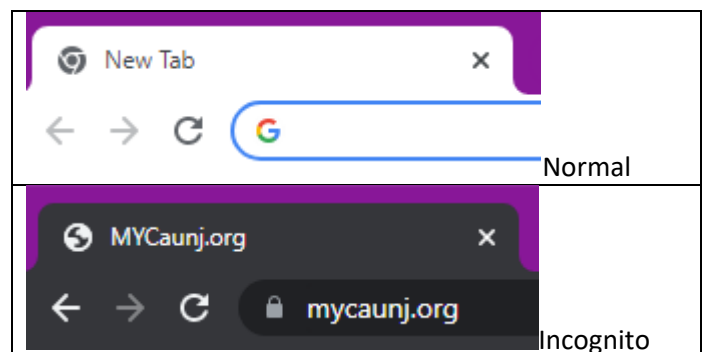


Here is what the Incognito window looks like:
